

Medium Green Print
section 1, patch 1
Light Green Print #1
section 1r, patch 1
Cream Print
sections 1 and 1r, patches 2–4
section 2, patches 2 and 3
Light Green Print #2
section 2, patch 1

Make 3 paper copies *each* of foundation sections 1 and 1r and 1 paper copy of section 2. Foundation piece the sections in numerical order, pressing and trimming after each patch addition.

Sew the sections together as shown to complete the block. $\ \blacksquare$




Section 1 Make 3

Block Assembly

Foundation Piecing creates accurate points and allows blocks to be joined with precision!

Refresher Steps to Foundation Piecing:

- Place the 1st piece of fabric on the undrawn side of the foundation, right side up, overlapping the drawn line by 1/4". Place the 2nd piece right side down on top of the 1st, matching cut edges. Pin (be sure to position the pin out of the stitching line.
- Using a short stitch length, stitch the line, beginning and ending a stitch or two beyond the ends of the line.
- 3) Open the 2nd piece, pressing it flat against the foundation.
- 4) Turn to the marked side of the foundation paper, fold the foundation on the next sewing line, and time excess fabric to ¼" to form an accurate placement line for the next piece of fabric.
- 5) Continue adding pieces until foundation is covered.

Insider tip:

Try using 17# translucent vellum paper for your foundations

Suggested Scrap Sizes:

Piece 1 (Green): 10.5" x 3" Piece 2 (Cream): 8" x 4.5" Piece 3 (Cream): 8" x 4.5"
