



Presents Cornerstone
Block 12 for Jelly Roll Sampler Quilt-a-long

 Cutting instructions for one block:

 From each of two different solid 2.5" strips or the closest 2.5" print strips that read like solids, Cut two 2.5" x 2.5" squares for a total of 4 "A" squares.

 From each of two coordinating 2.5" print strips, cut two 2.5" x 2.5" squares and two 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles for a total of 4 "B" squares and 4 "C" rectangles.

 From another 2.5" strip cut four 2.5" x 8.5" rectangles for a total of 4 "D" rectangles.


 And from another 2.5" strip cut four 2.5" x 2.5" squares for 4 "E" squares.

Piecing instructions for one block:


 Sew the 4 A squares to the 4 B squares to the 4 A squares as shown:




 Sew the A/B units to the C rectangles as shown (be sure to keep the A/B units in the position shown):



 Then referring to the photo and the below diagram sew these four blocks together as shown:




 Next sew two of the D rectangles to the top and bottom of this pieced center as shown:





 Sew the four E squares to each end of the two remaining D rectangles as shown:



 Finally sew these D/E units to the sides of the main section as shown:
