

# Jelly Roll Sampler - Block 2

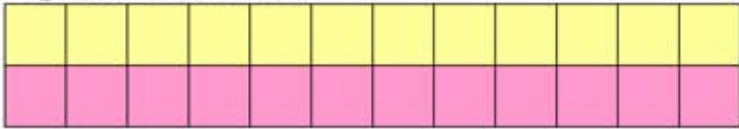
## 12 1/2" block (12" Finished)

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For this block, you will need three 2 1/2" jelly roll strips and background fabric. Refer to the diagram at the end of these instructions for color placement when forming units.

Sew two jelly roll strips together along the long edge. Cut the sewn strips into twelve 2 1/2" two block units.

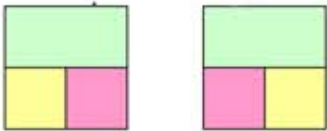


Sew two of the two block units together to make a 4 patch blocks. Repeat for a total of four 4 patch blocks - these will be your corner blocks.



From the third Jelly Roll strip cut four 4 1/2" strips - these will be your side strips.

Sew each side strip to one 2 patch strip along the long side. Make 2 with the darker patch on the right and 2 with the darker patch on the left for a total of 4 units.



From Background Fabric, cut one 4 1/2" square - this will be your center square.

Assemble the blocks as shown:
